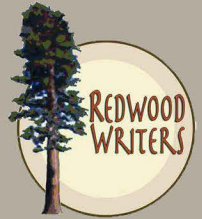

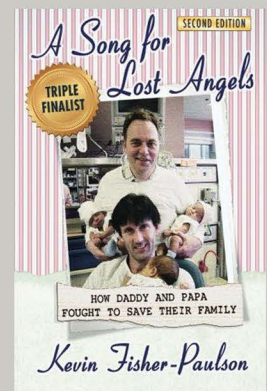
## Kevin Thaddeus Fisher-Paulson A Self-Guided Guide to the Self
