DEADLINE for Submission is October 31, 2018, 9:00 p.m.

- > Poets must be members of Redwood Writers.
- **Each poet may submit up to 5 poems.**
- All poems must be submitted through website at redwoodwriters.org
- Your name must NOT appear on poems.
 Include the title on the poem of each poem submitted.
- > Please submit poems in Times New Roman 12 point font. Include a 50 word bio written in 3rd person.
- Poems must be original and unpublished. Poems that have appeared in print, including online magazines, are <u>not</u> eligible. However, they may have appeared in personal blogs or online newsletters.



POETRY WORKSHOP – SEPT 22 – over for details

- Poets will be notified on receipt of submissions.
- Poets will be notified of accepted poems by December 1.
- Award of Merit: Three poets will be selected for exemplary work and featured in the book.
